Check-In

Whether it is your first time here or you've been coming to The Grove for a long time, we ask that you please check in your child at least 5 minutes prior to the service you are attending. You can check them in at one of our computer kiosks where two tags will be printed off for your child. One tag will go on your child and the other you will keep to show to the class teacher when you return to pick up your child. These tags help us keep track of important information about each child.

child dedication

greenhouse :: 8:00 / 9:30 / 11:00

The Greenhouse is our ministry to children ages birth – kindergarten. We desire to support parents in raising their children to become fully devoted followers and worshippers of Jesus Christ in a fun, safe and creative environment. To help in this process, we have divided the children into 6 classes: Nursery (infant and newborn), Crawlers (moving but not walking), Walkers (walking under age 2), 2 year olds, 3–4 year olds, and 5's/ Kindergarten. If you have any questions about which class is the right fit, feel free to ask one of our room leaders or children's staff.

Sick Policy

We operate a Well–baby program. For the protection of all the children in our ministry, we cannot accept a child with a running nose, fresh cold (4 days or less), fever, rash, persistent cough, diarrhea, or any other signs of illness. We request that you do not place your child in the program while they are at risk of exposing other children.

Check In

Please check in your child at least 5 minutes prior to the service you are attending. You can check them in at any of the computer check in locations where a tag will be printed for each of your children. Pick up your child immediately after the service has ended.



clubhouse :: 9:30 / 11:00

The Clubhouse is our ministry to children ages 1st–4th Grade. As in The Greenhouse, we are committed to seeing children learn God's truth in a biblical, fun and engaging environment. In Clubhouse, you will find an environment and program that is properly geared at this age group and developmental level, providing a wide array of ways for our Children to interact with each other, the teachers, and God's Word!

To help us accomplish this, we divide the students into two separate classes: 1st/2nd Grade, and 3rd/4th Grade. In those classes they will have a time of worship, large group teaching and interaction, activity and small group table time with their teacher and students in their grade and gender. At the end of each class, students are also given a take home sheet for you as parents to go through and further their learning and application.

Sick Policy

The sick policy for Clubhouse is the same as The Greenhouse. We ask that you adhere to this policy to help us maintain a safe and healthy environment for all the children and families that attend The Grove on a given Sunday. Thank You.



Dedication Information For Your Child

What Is Dedication?

Dedicating your child is when you as parents make a covenant or promise with God before a body of believers to raise your child in a Christian environment where biblical foundation is key.

Do I Need To Register?

Yes, complete the dedication form and turn it into the front office or contact any of the Kids At The Grove staff.

Is There An Age Limit?

Yes. Birth through 10 years of age.

What Are The Parent's Responsibilities?

They must be a believer and active in worship. Here's what you can expect: You will meet with the Pastor prior to the service you selected to get your child dedicated. The family will be asked to come on stage in the beginning of worship. This includes all siblings.

The Pastor will ask you if you agreed to raise your child according to God's word, which you publicly agree. Then he will ask the congregation to support you in that commitment. At that point, your child will be prayed over, they will receive an age appropriate children's Bible. You as parents will receive a dedication certificate and a parent devotional by James and Shirley Dobson called Night Light.
